Smithfield Village

Located in Cairns' northern beach suburbs, Smithfield Village was constructed on the sandy loam of what was once sugar cane land. Landscape Development had the unique task of shaping this old farm with the construction of public open spaces, nature walks and bio retention basins.

The focus on reef protection using bio retention basins capable of carrying huge tropical downpour runoff was challenging. These basins were developed with natural plantings, providing filter systems to 'clean' the storm water prior to it entering the reef system.

Construction of the POS's incorporating public art, shelters, bbq's and shaded playgrounds has made life at the village what we expect of living in the tropics.

Smithfield Village is manicured to perfection without looking out of place in the natural rainforest backdrop.

With stunning views to the nearby hills, Smithfield Village has without doubt set a new benchmark for landscape quality, environmental sensitivity and outstanding presentation in far north Queensland.
